Deadline for submission of artwork: 28 May 2021

Drop off and pick up at SIMED: 12 June 2021, 9 am to 12 pm

Artwork will hang at SIMED for 6 months, tentatively ending on 4 December 2021

No payments will be accepted at SIMED when the artwork is dropped off; fees must be paid through GFAA.

Number of Artworks to be Submitted


Up to three pieces of artwork may be submitted per artist.

Theme

There is no theme. Just make sure the artwork is suitable for a medical facility where they will be viewed by persons of all ages and backgrounds.

Submitting Artwork

Email images of artwork to be submitted to Teresa Yawn at <u>tmd@teresamariedreams.com</u>, showing front and back side of the artwork. Include a tape measure or ruler next to the image as a size reference; the ruler does not have to span the entire image.



The artwork must have proper wiring on the back for hanging; use D-rings screwed into the artwork to attach the wire and make sure the wire is strong enough to hold the artwork.



Have a label affixed to the back of the artwork; use the labels at the end of these instructions.

Labels for viewers to read will be printed by Teresa Yawn for the artists; the labels will stick to the walls and will not be affixed to the artwork. Send Teresa, in the same email with the attached images, the following information:

Artist's name
Artwork title
Artwork size, in inches, width x height
Medium
Price
Artist's phone number


Note: Sales will no longer go through GFAA. Buyers will contact artists directly. When a buyer contacts you for a sale, let Teresa know about the sale and give her the information on the new artwork that is put in place.

Dropping artwork off at SIMED: 5 June 2021, 9 am to 12 pm

We will follow the same instructions used in December under pandemic conditions, so the following instructions will remain as they are: artwork will be dropped off under the overhang by the front door and only the persons hanging the exhibit will be inside the building.

If the pandemic improves, we may change some of these rules, but we will have to wait and see how things are going. Teresa will update you as we approach the drop off date.



Because of the pandemic, we want to minimize contact. The above map shows how to drop off your artwork and retrieve artwork from the previous exhibit. Before you leave your house, please make sure your artwork is prepared and ready to go on the wall!! Make sure your label is on the back and have the other label attached to the bottom right corner—be careful handling your artwork so the label does not get crumpled.

IF YOU FEEL ILL OR SICK OR HAVE BEEN IN CONTACT WITH SOMEONE WHO HAS COVID-19, DO NOT COME! ARRANGE FOR SOMEONE ELSE TO DROP OFF YOUR ARTWORK.

If it is not possible for you to safely get your artwork to SIMED on this date because of illness or contact with COVID-19, "place holder" art will be put in your designated spots and when you are able to get your artwork to SIMED, the place holder art will be removed and your art put in place.

- 1. Enter SIMED by coming in on 44^{th} St. and follow the yellow arrows on the map (there will be no arrows on the road or in the parking lot).
- 2. Stay in your car. If there are cars in front of you, remain in line and move as the line moves.
- 3. When you get to the overhang by the front door, pull under the overhang and stop. Put your mask on BEFORE exiting your car. Your artwork will be received and added to the exhibit and you will receive your artwork from the previous exhibit.
- 4. Get back in your car, leave the overhang, follow the yellow arrows on the map and exit out through the east parking lot.
